





Our centre is one of the nine pre-primary service units under the Hong Kong Sheng Kung Hui Welfare Council. It adopts the concept of "Child-Centered and Educare" to cultivate the health and balanced growth of children. Through multidisciplinary teamwork and home-school collaboration, infants and young children can grow in love.

We emphasize qualification and professional standard of the teachers. All of our teachers are "registered child care workers" recognized by the Government. They are committed to cultivate all-round development of infants and young children. The Welfare Council organizes professional trainings for staff regularly to enhance their professional development. To support families in need, school social worker will be arranged to station at the centre to provide preventive, developmental and therapeutic social work services for children and their families.

To cater for families with sudden engagements and commitments. The provision of OCCS aims to provide flexible modes of service, 2-hour session care, half-day care and full-day care to cater for different needs of families.

每節費用(2小時)為\$16, 另加膳食費\$6.5 Fee for 2-hour session care is \$16 with Meal fee \$6.5 per day.



我們重視嬰幼兒的成長發展,在課程設計方面,配合 「**放發探索課程**」,強調課程實踐的四大策略:










We value the development of infants and young children and adopt the "Discovery Curriculum" with emphasis on the following four strategies:



Respond to the needs of children and build a trustful relationship with sense of security by "Responsive approach"

Establish a close relationship with infants and young children via the "Interaction Approach"

Arouse learning motivation through "Play-based Approach"

本中心為不同年齡組別提供配合成長需要的餐膳安排,包括早午餐、水果及茶點。中心亦為幼兒安排配合年齡需要的配方奶粉,家長亦可按需要自備母乳或特別配方奶粉。

Balanced and nutritious diet catering for the development of children at different ages will be provided. Breakfast, lunch, fruit and snack will be served. The centre also supplies standard formula milk that meets the nutritional needs of children. Parents can also provide breastmilk or preferred formula milk to the centre for feeding their child.
